

A Night of Mandopop Memories: Panda Hsiung Brings 2026 Concert World Tour to Arena of Stars

Genting Highlands, 9 March 2026 – This April, love ballads return to the highlands in full force. Resorts World Genting is proud to present the highly anticipated Panda Hsiung (熊天平) 2026 World Tour, taking place on 11 April 2026 at 6pm at the Arena of Stars.

His music is more than nostalgia; it is memory, comfort and companionship through life’s turning points.

This Malaysia stop is designed as more than a standard concert. With a focus on musicality and storytelling, the show places the spotlight on the songs; the melodies that rise and fall like heartbeats, the subtle turns in every phrase, and the emotional weight carried in every lyric. With his signature guitar in hand, Panda Hsiung will transform Arena of Stars into an intimate gathering where audiences can hear every delicate vibrato and feel every lingering pause.

Audiences can expect a carefully curated setlist of timeless classics and fan favourites like “熊心万丈” (Boundless Heart), “最后还是会” (In the End, I Still) and “一个人流浪” (Wandering Alone), alongside other beloved hits that defined the golden era of Mandopop. The evening will also allow space for fresh arrangements and spontaneous musical moments, giving fans the opportunity to experience familiar songs in new and moving ways.

Joining him as a special guest artiste is Marina (杨洋), a celebrated singer-songwriter. Known for her works “天涯共此时” (Sharing This Moment), “团团圆圆” (Together Again) and “我很想家” (Homesick), Marina brings international artistry and cross-cultural depth to the stage. Together the duo’s chemistry adds another emotional dimension to the evening, blending heartfelt storytelling with powerful vocal harmony.

Tickets are priced at RM388 (VIP), RM288 (PS1), RM198 (PS2), and RM88 (PS3). A processing fee of RM4 applies per ticket. Ticket pre-sales will open on 10 March 2026 at 12pm for Genting Rewards Card (RWC) Gold members and above while public sales will open on 13 March 2026

Set against the cool highland air, Arena of Stars will transform into a sea of swaying lights and collective voices, where every chorus becomes a shared memory and every melody invites new emotions.
